BSCA Rules for the FRENCH COURSE https://bsca.info/french-style-herding/ AKC has agreed to recognize this French Style program under the BSCA Parent Club administered Performance Event program. https://images.akc.org/pdf/titles/AKC Recognized Parent Club Titles.pdf Breeds that may use this program in full recognition are Belgian Sheepdog, Belgian Tervuren, Belgian Lakenois, Belgian Malinois, German Shepherd dog. BSCA allows any AKC herding dog OTHER than border collies and kelpies to run on their courses. The French course involves tending style with the dog working close to the livestock. Unlike C course, several obstacles and short drives (dog taking stock ahead of the handler) in advance and a gather are required and furrows / boundaries are not. An illustrated description of the course for each level is included.

ADDITIONAL RULES

We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping keep the Test/Trial location as clean as possible in order for us to retain the use of this facility for future Test/Trials.

No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entries must be received at the Trial Secretary's address by the published closing date to be acceptable, and may not be changed, substituted, corrected, signed or cancelled after that time except as provided in Chapter 3, Section I of the General Rules for Herding Tests and Herding Trials. Incomplete, unsigned, conditionals, telephone entries received without fees are not acceptable.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will assess a collection fee of \$30.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent from the same exhibitor may result in their being put upon a cashonly basis.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries must be on the enclosed blank or a reasonable facsimile thereof.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian, judge or tester or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Dogs must be ready for their classes. Trial judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog that does not appear within five minutes of being called for its run.

The Trial-giving Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authority, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulation will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

- Please have all dogs NOT actively working ON LEAD or in a crate.

ELIGIBILITY

All dogs nine months of age or older other than Border Collies and Kelpies that are registered with the American Kennel Club and classified as Herding Dogs under Chapter 2 of the Dog Show Rules are eligible to participate in herding tests and trials. Dogs classified as Herding Dogs under Chapter 2 of the Dog Show Rules that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) may participate in tests and trials.

No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any test/trial.

Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at the end of the class in tests, and in catalog order as listed in the class in trials.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for the herding test or trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any herding test or Trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition. regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his or her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (for complete rule refer to Chap. 14, Sect 3 of "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows")

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests and Trials" have been made available to me (us) and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its' members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in the Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

From Lancaster, LA area head North to MOJAVE. .

Take 1-14 NORTH to Mojave CA. BE sure to then continue on 1-14 (RIGHT turn –you'll pass Stater Bro)



From Bakersfield head SOUTH on 58 to Mojave then take turn LEFT onto 14 going NORTH.

Continue to 178 EAST. Take 178 E – you will see sign for Ridgecrest/ Inyokern . This road is also called INYOKERN ROAD.



You will pass thru Inyokern. LOOK for sign showing 395 onramp. You will take dirt road JUST in front of the onramp. Turn RIGHT. Property is about 1 mile down the dirt road that parallels the highway.



From San Bernadino – take 395 North to Inyokern and exit INYOKERN turn left then turn left on moonwind.

From N. Nevada – take 395 South to second Invokern exit, turn left, then left onto moonwind.


The following course diagrams are tentative. Courses are set just prior to the trial and at the judge's determination and plots for the course / level are provided approximately one hour prior to the trial. These indicate the type of tasks involved.

The course layout provided is from previous event. The actual course will be set by the judge on day of trial.

ADVANCED Handler & dog begin at pen 1. Dog goes in and collects stock. Handler should not enter this pen. Collect stock and exit via gates thru pens and alley to pen 2. Upon reaching pen 2, the dog should make room for the handler to examine the sheep and reach the gate leading to the A course arena. Handler opens gate and stock exit this pen. This gate must then be closed. The dog should control the sheep until this is accomplished. The handler then takes a path straight up the center of the arena left of the centerlines, turns at the handler's post and goes the other direction on the other side of the centerline, then turns again and goes up the arena on the E side of the arena, then drive the Z (handler must follow dog). Upon reaching gate by hold exam, the dog must stop flock for handler to open the gate. Stock then enter pen. The green pen gate exit is CLOSED and dog must again make room for handler to reach this gate and open it. Dog must hold stock in this process. Exit from this pen via aisle into HI/HX graze area. Graze and do catch and hold. Gather stock and enter HS graze arena. Circle arena. Stock should NOT go near HS graze area. Then exit into A arena, then back down arena. Stop and drive centerlines. IN pen, sort out 5 sheep into nearest hold pen, then let remaining stock into aisle. Remove stock from hold pen and also let them go down alley and return all stock to pen 1.



Intermediate Handler can take any position relative to dog & sheep until gather unless otherwise stated. begin in pen 1. Dog should go in first. (yellow/green line). collect stock from pen 1. Exit via gates thru pens and alley to pen 2. The dog should make room for the handler to examine the sheep and reach the gate leading to the A course arena. Handler opens gate and stock exit this pen. This gate must then be closed. The dog should control the sheep until this is accomplished. The handler then takes a path straight up the center of the arena left of the centerlines and going towards the Z chute just past the hold exam, there is another gate. Dog must stop flock for handler to open the gate. Stock then enter pen. The green pen gate exit is CLOSED and dog must again make room for handler to reach this gate and open it. Dog must hold stock in this process. Exit from this pen via aisle into HI/HX graze area. Graze and do catch and hold. Gather stock and transit aisle back into arena A. Stock should NOT go near HS graze area. In A arena, take stock around HX handler's post then back down arena. Stop and drive centerlines., then return to pen 1.



Started. Handler can take any position relative to dog & sheep until gather unless otherwise stated. begin in pen 1. Dog should go n first. (yellow/green line). collect stock from pen 1. Exit via gates thru pens and alley to pen 2. The dog should make room for the handler to examine the sheep and reach the gate leading to the A course arena. Handler opens gate and stock exit this pen. This gate must then be closed. The dog should control the sheep until this is accomplished. The handler then takes a path straight up the center of the arena left of the centerlines and going towards the Z chute just past the hold exam, there is another gate --open gate and transit via this into arena B. Set stock on graze. CATCH and Hold done here, then gather from graze. Exit via same route back to pen 1..
